KAAC Board Membership--Questions and Answers

Who is eligible?

"Any school representative, coach, certified official or employee of a member school, or school district containing a member school, is eligible to be elected to the Board." (*KAAC Bylaws*)

If a person retires after being elected as a full-time employee, that person may remain on the Board.

As long as the criteria above are met, representatives from both public and private schools are eligible.

How does the nomination and election process work?

Nominees must obtain the signatures of three school representatives from three different KAAC member schools within the section and return the form to KAAC. All school representatives then vote online. The person with the most votes joins the Board.

What are the responsibilities of Board members?

The KAAC Board of Directors establishes and monitors the policies for the governance and operation of the Association and its activities.

Are Board members paid?

Board members are reimbursed for mileage and travel expenses and, if necessary, school districts are compensated for the cost of a substitute.

When does the Board meet?

The Board, active in all aspects of the Association, has regular meetings four times a year: usually in July, September, January and May. The January meeting is held by teleconference. Attendance is also required at a summer retreat, usually in July, and at the Governor's Cup State Finals in March. Board members elected this winter will be inducted in July.

Why we need your help

Our goal is to meet the needs of every Kentucky student with the benefits of academic competition.

Why? We believe in it. Properly structured academic competition can be a great thing for kids, a great thing for schools and a great thing for communities.

We've added the Sixth Grade Showcase and a competition for ninth and tenth graders, the Student Loan People JV Challenge. We began in 2006 offering questions for leagues across the state, and now have Summer Camps for both Middle and High School students.

And there's more we're working on.


